▪ **Audiology - from gene to environment 15 ECTS**

Hearing is an extremely important sensory organ for our social interactions. But it does not work as an isolated sensory organ, several factors interact and can affect function, such as genetic, environmental, health and lifestyle factors. This course has the ambition to link these factors and provide an overall picture of auditory function in its complex context.

The course is distanced based with flexible quarter time and will be given in mixed Swedish /English or strictly English depending on the students home language. The course will run from August 2009 – June 2010. Special eligibility: Bachelor's degree 180 higher education credits.

▪ **Deafblindness in a life perspective 15 ECTS**

Specific deafblind requirements change during life and in different situations. Therefore this course has a life-course approach. The different themes include social, emotional as well as physical issues in relation to environment and personal deafblind specific requirements. The course deals with the requirements in relation to support and service by the society, next of a kin and others in an accessibility perspective with the goal full participation. Lectures will be given by excellent expertise as well as researchers and practitioners as well as teachers with deafblindness themselves in an interdisciplinary way with health as its hallmark. The course is distanced based with flexible quarter time and will be given in mixed Swedish /English or strictly English depending on the students home language. The course will run from August 2009 – June 2010. Special eligibility: Bachelor's degree 180 higher education credits.
